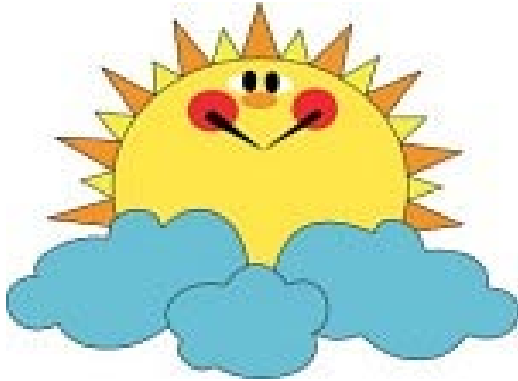


LCBA Spring Bash

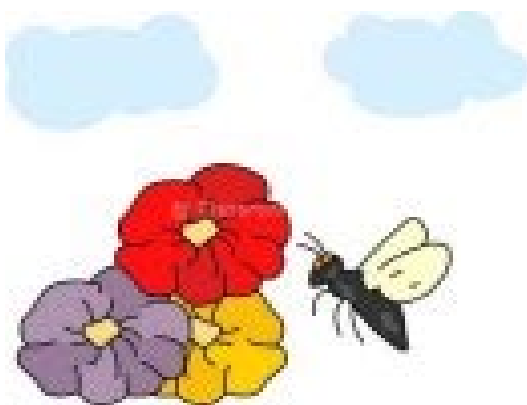
