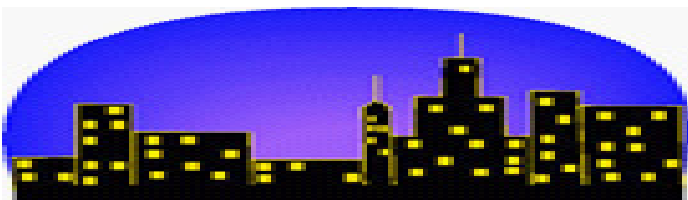
STEPHEN VORHES

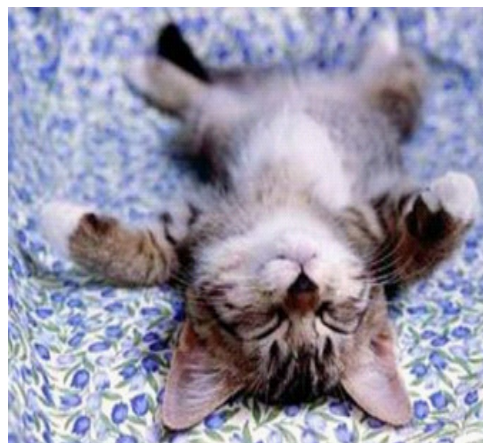

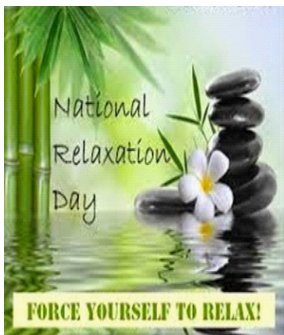
