Deadlines

The *Bar News* is published 12 times annually, on a monthly basis. The deadline for all copy is the **19th of the month** preceding publication. Submissions may be held until a later month.

Style

- Articles may be submitted via email and in MS Word or RTF formal (not PDF).
- If your submission includes a photo, please provide a color, high resolution, digital photo and identify the individual(s) in the photo (and credit the photographer, as needed).
- All submissions are reviewed for clarity, length, grammar, spelling and style. The LCBA Board reserves the right to make changes for length and/or to ensure consistent editorial policy and style. The LCBA Board will attempt to notify the author of any style and length edits made.
- Submissions may be held for later issues if space and topic constraints dictate. Unsolicited submissions are published at the discretion of the editor.

Types of Submissions-Specific Directions

- **Letters** should generally relate to issues or opinions germane to the practice of law in Lane County.
- Articles should include the author's byline.
 Topics should be timely and as specific to the
 Lane County legal community as is possible.
 Please also provide a photo.
- Around the Bar materials should report on LCBA members' awards, honors, moves and transitions. Listings from other publications (e.g. Superlawyers®, Best Lawyers®, etc...) will not be included.
- **Profiles** of lawyers and judges are welcome. Please propose the intended profile to the editor before submitting an article.
